Program Components:

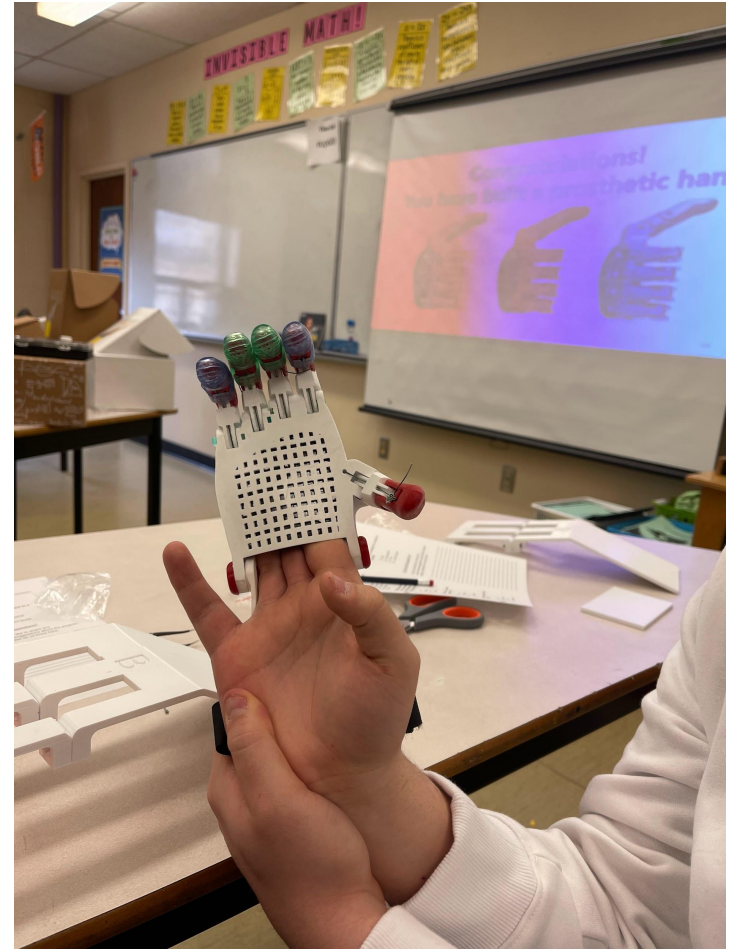

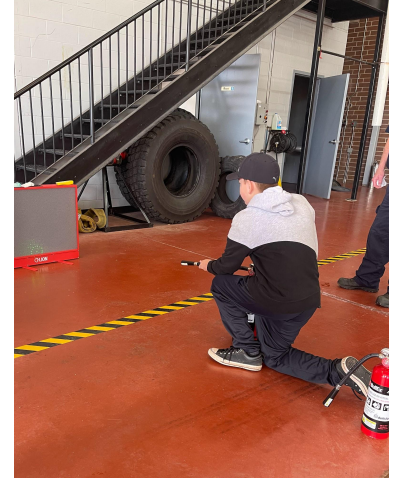


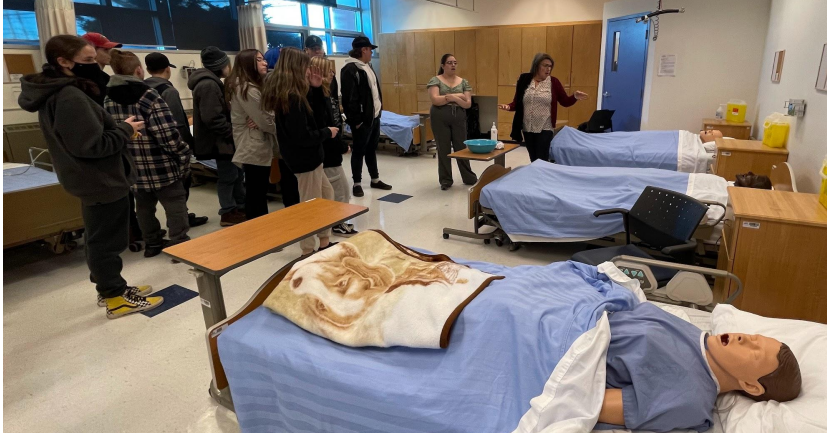




Depending on student interests, we...

Make connections between school, community, and workplace through hands-on, inquiry-based learning experiences.



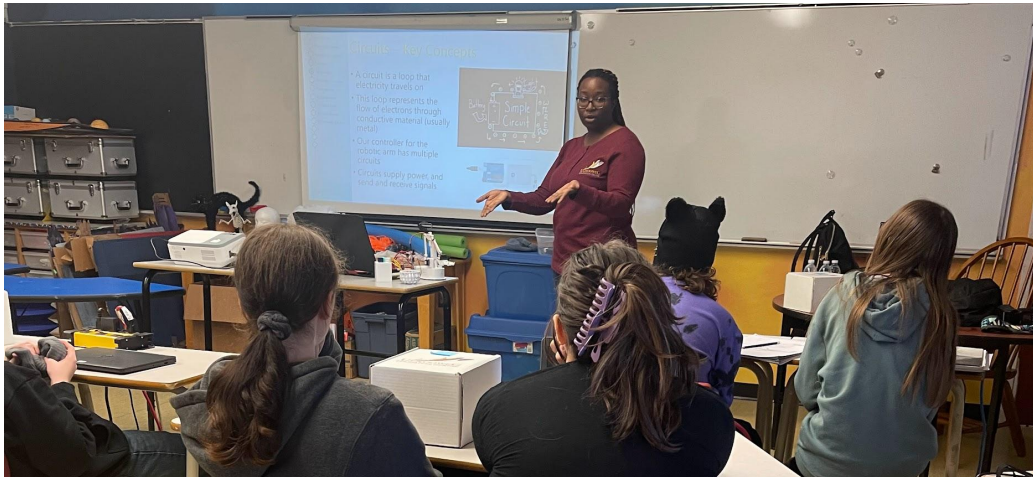






Students receive:

First Aid Certification

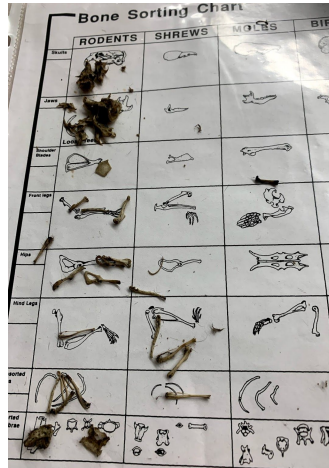
